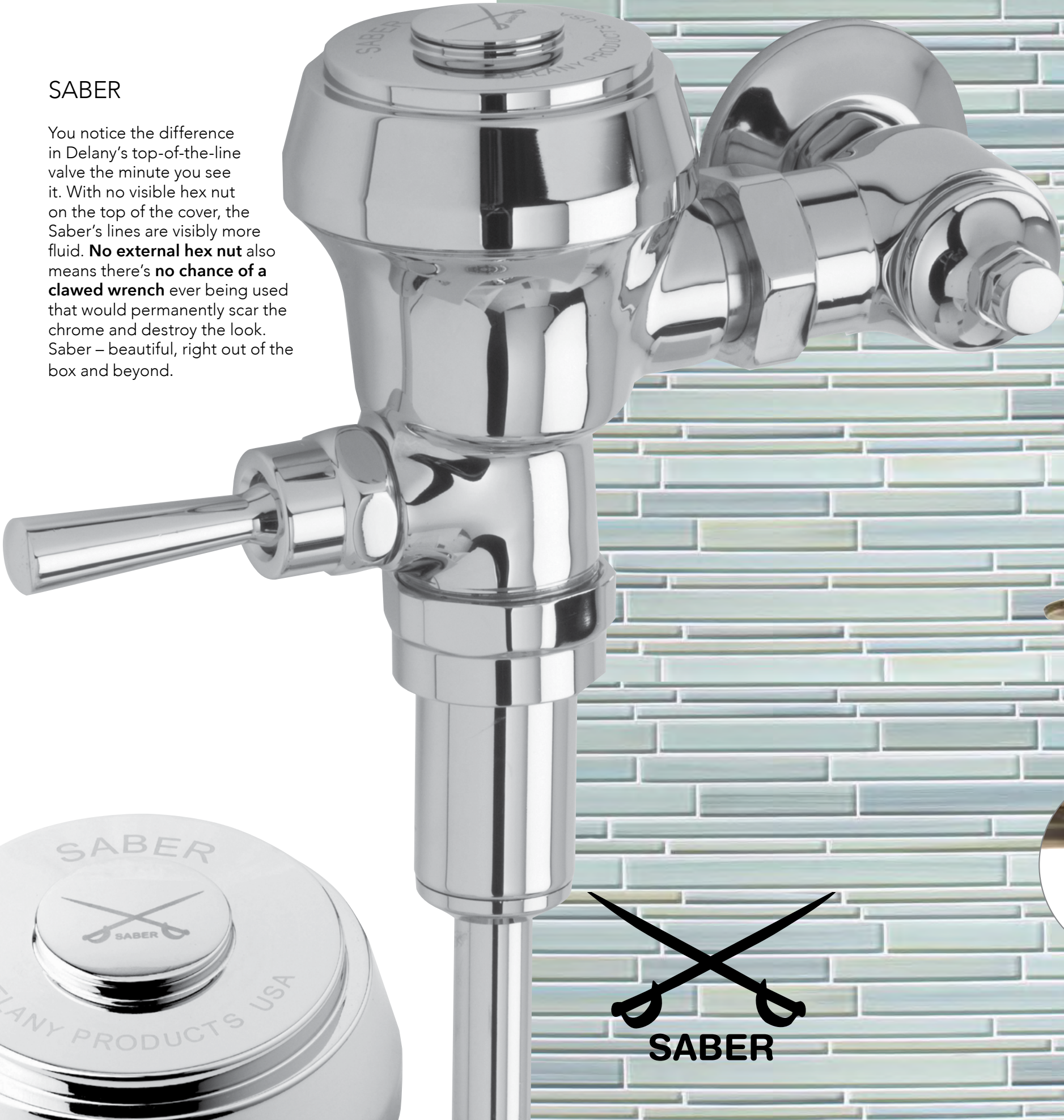


SABER

The Differences

The Upper Chamber Regulating Screw allows for True-in-the-Field Water Conservation by allowing just a little more or a little less water in less than optimal circumstances.

Delany's Mashaerator diaphragm, standard on every Saber valve, prevents hard water build up and keeps the bypass free of debris.
